Sobre las tarifas de la MTA: Se requiere una tarifa. Utilice monedas, billetes de dólar, pase semanal o mensual o CharmCard. Las máquinas automáticas de cobro de boletos no dan cambio.

Para tener derecho a tarifas reducidas en los servicios de transporte de la Administración de Transporte de Maryland (Maryland Transit Administration, MTA) usted debe mostrar uno de los siguientes documentos:

Números telefónicos importantes de la MTA: Tarjetas ligeros de transporte (Light Rail), Metro Subway y el Tren MARC: (Commuter Bus) y el Tren MARC.

INSTRUCTIONS

How to Use the MTA Timetables Timetables should be read left to right for stops and down for times: 1. Select correct day of the week and destination of travel.

About MTA Fares: Exact fare is required. Use coins, dollar bills, day, weekly or monthly passes, or CharmCard/SmartTrip cards. Fareboxes do not give change.

To be eligible for reduced fares on MTA transit services, you must show one of the following: Senior citizens (age 65+)

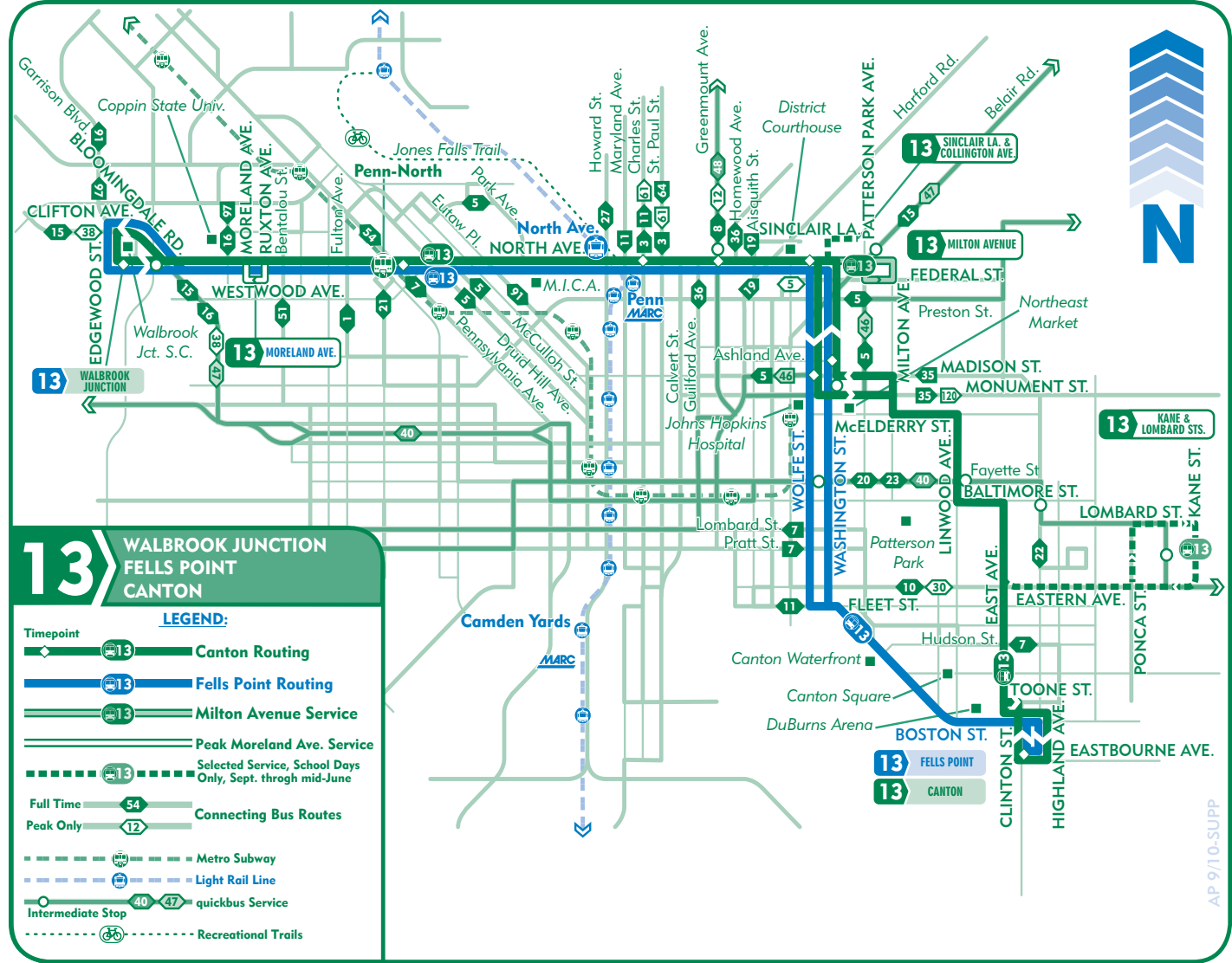

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Supplemental Service Between September and mid-June (except on major holidays) select trips (not shown on attached schedule) will operate Monday through Friday between 7:00 & 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 & 4:00 p.m. via the following routes:

E/B - to Kane loop (Via Linwood Ave.) via regular route to East Ave. & Eastern Ave. then via (L) Eastern Ave., (L) Ponca St., (L) New Ponca St., (R) Lombard St., (R) Kane St. to bus stop between first two driveways.

W/B - From Kane loop (Patterson High School) via S Kane St., (R) Eastern Ave., to (R) East Ave., then via regular route.

E/B - From Walbrook Jct. to North Ave. & Milton St. (via Sinclair La.) via North Ave. to Washington St., then (L) Washington St., (R) Sinclair La. to Collington Ave. where passengers will disembark, then continue, (S) Sinclair La. (R) Patterson Park Ave. to North Ave., then via regular route to North Ave. & Milton Ave.

W/B - From Sinclair La. & Collington Ave. at loading zone to Walbrook via (S) Sinclair La., (L) Chester St., (R) North Ave., then via regular route.
