INSTRUCCIONES

Cómo utilizar los horarios de la Administración de Transporte de Maryland (MTA)

- 1. Seleccione el día de la semana correcto y el destino del viaje.
2. Seleccione la ubicación más cercana a su punto de abordaje, luego busque debajo el horario en el que el autobús se encontrará en dicha ubicación.
3. El horario o el mapa no indican todas las paradas del autobús.
4. Los destinos se indican hacia la derecha de su punto de salida.
5. Los recorridos, servicios expresos y suplementarios en días especiales se detallan en las notas al pie.
6. Todos los horarios son aproximados.
7. Los autobuses pararán únicamente en las paradas de autobús designadas.
8. Los puntos de trasbordo se muestran al elegir las rutas de autobuses que se cruzan en el mapa.

Sobre las tarifas de la MTA

- 1. Se requiere una tarifa exacta. Utilice monedas, billetes de dólar, pase semanal o mensual o CharmCard.
2. Tarifas básicas para los autobuses locales, tranvía eléctrico (Light Rail) y tren subterráneo (Metro Subway) de la MTA: \$1.60 boleto de ida, \$3.50 boleto para todo el día (viajes ilimitados durante todo el día).
3. Dos niños de bajo 6 años montan libremente cuando acompañado por un adulto del precio completo.
4. Tarifas básicas para personas mayores de edad y para personas con impedimentos: \$54 boleto de ida, \$1.20 boleto para todo el día (viajes ilimitados durante todo el día).

INSTRUCTIONS

How to Use the MTA Timetables

- 1. Select correct day of the week and destination of travel.
2. Select the location closest to your boarding point, then read down to the time a bus will be at this location.
3. All bus stops are not shown in the timetable or on the map.
4. Destinations are shown to the right of your starting point.
5. Route patterns, express and supplemental seasonal services are noted in footnotes.
6. All times are approximate.
7. Buses will stop at designated bus stops only.
8. Transfer points are shown by listing the intersecting bus routes on the map.

About MTA Fares:

- 1. Exact fare is required. Use coins, dollar bills, day, weekly or monthly passes, or CharmCard/SmartTrip cards.
2. Basic fares on MTA Local Buses, Light Rail and Metro Subway: \$1.60 one-way, \$3.50 Day Pass (unlimited daily travel).
3. Two children under 6 yrs. ride free when accompanied by a full fare.
4. Basic fares for seniors and persons with disabilities: \$54 one-way, \$1.20 Day Pass (unlimited daily travel).
5. To be eligible for reduced fares on MTA transit services, you must show one of the following:
- A valid MTA Senior photo ID card,
- Any valid government issued photo ID with proof of age, or
- A Medicare card and any valid government issued photo ID

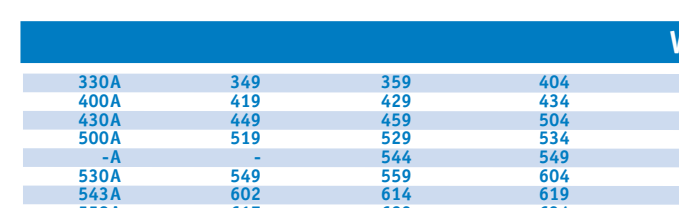
