

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS PROPOSED NEW EXPRESS COMMUTER BUS SERVICE BETWEEN BALTIMORE, ANNAPOLIS, AND KENT ISLAND

The Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) gives notice of three public hearings to provide interested persons the opportunity to comment on proposed New Express Commuter Bus service operating between Baltimore, Annapolis, and Kent Island, on line Nos. 210 and 215. The proposed service is part of MTA's BaltimoreLink project to improve the quality and reliability of bus service across the Region, and would be effective on or about March 1, 2017.
