



**Major Changes Since Draft 1 In Response to Community Feedback**

- Continuous bus service reintroduced through Dundalk, particularly along Wise Avenue: the previously-proposed LocalLinks 27, 61, and 63 divided service into three segments whereas the new LocalLinks 61 and 62 function much like the current 4.
- Express service reintroduced to Eastern Avenue, Fox Ridge, and Whispering Woods via Express BusLink 160.



Please note that the proposed route changes below apply only to Baltimore County Legislative District 6. To learn about proposed changes to these routes in other districts, please consult the maps for those districts.



- 4 CCBC Essex to Turner Station**  
Divided into two routes: LocalLink 61 (CCBC Essex to Eastpoint Mall) and LocalLink 62 (Eastpoint Mall to Turner Station).
- 10 Route 40 Plaza or Paradise to Bullneck Road**  
Replaced by **CityLink Navy** (Mondawmin to Dundalk or Watersedge).
- 23 Route 40 Plaza or Wildwood to Fox Ridge**  
Replaced by **CityLink Orange** (West Baltimore to Fox Ridge).
- 24 Moravia to Whispering Woods**  
Replaced by LocalLink 59 (Moravia to Whispering Woods). Service on Erdman/North Point/Rolling Mill in Colgate shifted to Eastern/Bayview to serve Bayview Medical Center.
- 31 State Center to CCBC Dundalk**  
Discontinued. Service on Dundalk Avenue absorbed into **CityLink Navy** and service on Dunman/Sollers Point absorbed into LocalLink 62.
- 35 UMBC or Blind Industries to White Marsh**  
Replaced by LocalLink 56 (Downtown to White Marsh).
- 44 Security Square to Rosedale**  
Replaced by LocalLink 30 (Rogers Avenue to Rosedale).
- 55 Towson to Fox Ridge**  
Replaced by LocalLink 36 (Towson to Fox Ridge).
- 40 CMS to Middle River**  
Replaced by **CityLink Orange** (West Baltimore to Fox Ridge).
- 160 Downtown and Johns Hopkins Hospital to Fox Ridge or Whispering Woods**  
Renamed to Express BusLink 160 but otherwise unchanged.

## WHAT IS BALTIMORELINK?

BaltimoreLink is a proposed transformation of the MTA bus system into a unified network of CityLink, LocalLink, and Express BusLink routes. CityLink routes will be color-coded, run 24 hours, offer frequent daytime service, and connect to Metro SubwayLink, Light RailLink, and MARC Train stations. It also includes the proposed construction of transfer facilities, dedicated bus lanes and signal priority, and improved bus stop signs, among many other improvements. Learn more at
