

Please note that the proposed route changes below apply only to Baltimore County Legislative District 7. To learn about proposed changes to these routes in other districts, please consult the maps for those districts.

- 4 CCBC Essex to Turner Station**
Divided into two routes: LocalLink 61 (CCBC Essex to Eastpoint Mall) and LocalLink 62 (Eastpoint Mall to Turner Station).
- 24 Moravia to Whispering Woods**
Replaced by LocalLink 59 (Moravia to Whispering Woods).
- 35 UMBC or Blind Industries to White Marsh**
Replaced by LocalLink 56 (Downtown to White Marsh).
- 55 Towson to Fox Ridge**
Replaced by LocalLink 36 (Towson to Fox Ridge).
- 160 Downtown and Johns Hopkins Hospital to Fox Ridge or Whispering Woods**
Renamed to Express BusLink 160 but otherwise unchanged.

**Major Changes Since Draft 1
In Response to Community Feedback**


- Express service reintroduced to Whispering Woods via Eastern Avenue on Express BusLink 160.
- LocalLink 59 revised to function more like the current 24: the previously-proposed LocalLink 59 turned to served Philadelphia Road / Pulaski Highway at Back River Neck Road, while the revised LocalLink 59 continues along Eastern to Moravia via Bayview Medical Center.
- Direct service between White Marsh and downtown Baltimore along Philadelphia Road / Pulaski Highway reintroduced via LocalLink 56.

WHAT IS BALTIMORELINK?

BaltimoreLink is a proposed transformation of the MTA bus system into a unified network of CityLink, LocalLink, and Express BusLink routes. CityLink routes will be color-coded, run 24 hours, offer frequent daytime service, and connect to Metro SubwayLink, Light RailLink, and MARC Train stations. It also includes the proposed construction of transfer facilities, dedicated bus lanes and signal priority, and improved bus stop signs, among many other improvements. Learn more at
