- Los horarios deben leerse de izquierda a derecha para las paradas y hacia abajo para los horarios. 1. Seleccione el día de la semana correcta y el destino del viaje. 2. Seleccione la ubicación más cercana a su punto de abordaje...

- Sobre las tarifas de la MTA: 1. Se requiere una tarifa exacta. Utilice monedas, billetes de dólar, pase semanal o mensual o CharmCard. 2. Tarifas básicas para los autobuses locales, tránsito eléctrico (Light Rail) y tren subterráneo (Metro Subwayway)...

- Personas con discapacidades: Una tarjeta de identificación de discapacidad vigente de la MTA con fotografía, o un documento de identificación de discapacidad vigente de otra agencia de tránsito y cualquier documento de identificación vigente con fotografía emitido por el gobierno...

Números telefónicos importantes de la MTA: Información sobre autobuses locales (Local Bus), el tren subterráneo (Metro Subwayway), el tren eléctrico (Light Rail), Autobus Comunitario (Commuter Bus) y el trolleador (Trolley).

INSTRUCTIONS

How to Use the MTA Timetables

- Timetables should be read left to right for stops and down for times: 1. Select correct day of the week and destination of travel. 2. Select the location closest to your boarding point, then read down to the time a bus will be at this location.

- About MTA Fares: 1. Exact fare is required. Use coins, dollar bills, day, weekly or monthly passes, or CharmCard/SmartTrip cards. 2. Basic fares on MTA Local Buses, Light Rail and Metro Subwayway: \$1.60 one-way, \$3.50 Day Pass (unlimited daily travel).

- Persons with disabilities: A valid MTA Senior photo ID card, or Any valid government issued photo ID with proof of age, or A Medicare card and any valid government issued photo ID...

Guaranteed Ride Home Program is available for personal emergencies and unscheduled overnight. Participants must register with Commuter Connections at (800) 745-7433 to use this service.

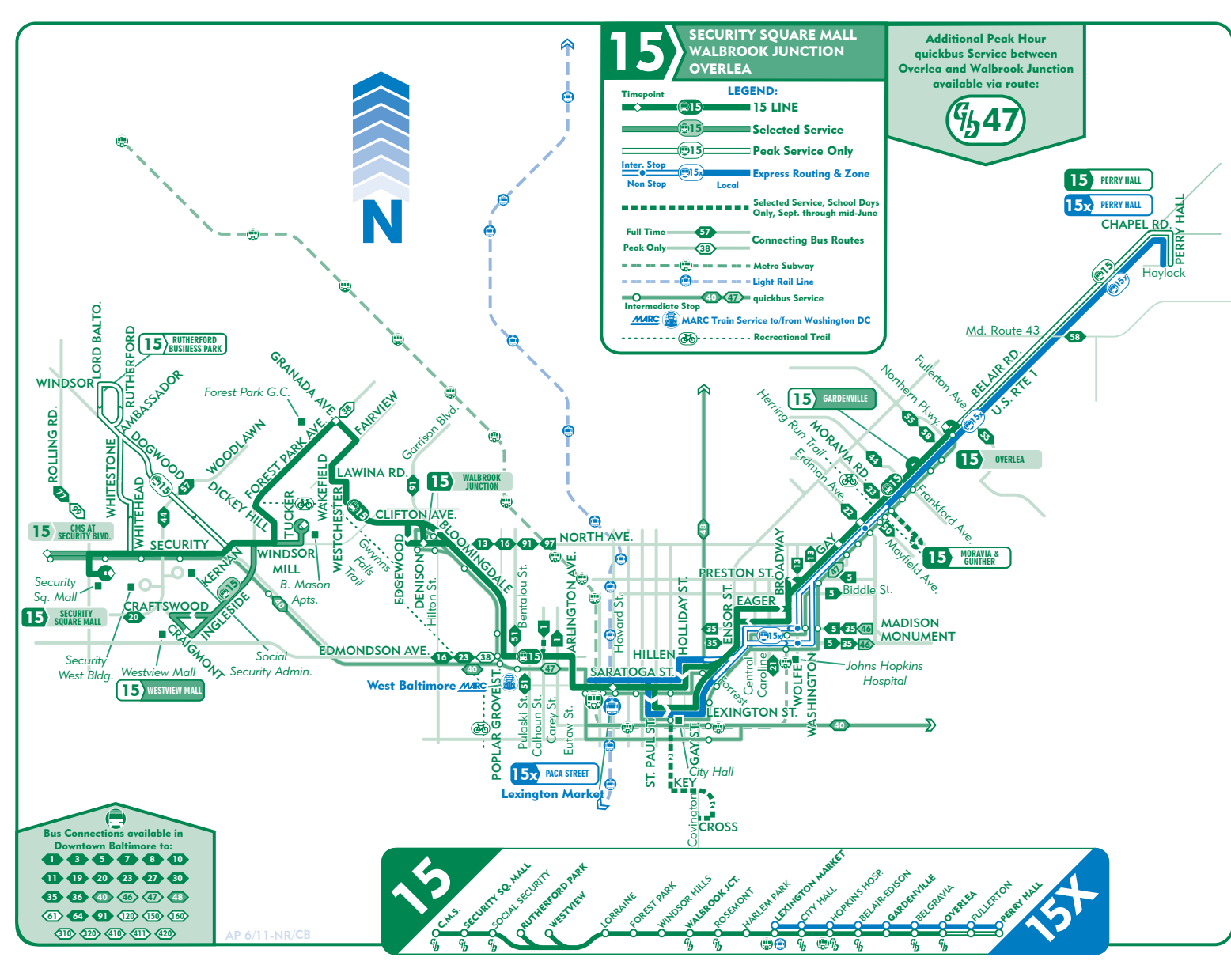
