

On Saturday, October 15, 2011 between 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., the Baltimore Marathon will cause major revisions to bus routes. Please allow extra time for your trip on this day.

MTA encourages transit riders to ride the Light Rail and Metro Subway to avoid downtown congestion.

The Baltimore Marathon will loop through many areas of Baltimore City, causing MTA to modify several bus routes to maintain service. This may require customers to catch a bus at a designated bus stop on a street that may not be a part of the normal route.

The bus routes that are diverted, split into separate loops or shortened are the Nos: 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 27, 35, 36, 40, 64, 91 and 98 (Hampden Shuttle). The No. 48 line will not operate during the Marathon. These are the only lines impacted for this event.

Please be aware some lines may be shortened, some may be diverted on adjacent streets to maintain service, and other lines may be cut into two or three separate loops as street closures necessitate. Service will be restored as soon as possible following the conclusion of the event, and all service is scheduled to be returned to normal by 5:00 p.m.

No. 1 Line: Route is blocked on Baltimore Street at Paca Street, Eutaw Street, Light Street and Calvert Street; on Fayette Street between Calvert Street and Paca Street. Hanover Street will be closed from Montgomery Street to Fort Avenue; Fort Avenue will be closed from Hanover Street to Fort McHenry Loop.

Service will operate between Sinai Hospital and the University of Maryland Transit Center (UMTC) only after 7:00 a.m. and no service will operate beyond the UMTC. When Southbound, buses will operate via the regular route through the Mondawmin station to Baltimore Street and the UMTC. When Northbound, from Baltimore Street and the UMTC, then right on Greene Street, right on Lombard Street, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Fayette Street, then via the regular route to Sinai Hospital.

Streets to Preston Street and Guilford Avenue, turning left on Guilford Avenue, left on Biddle Street, right on Caroline Street, left on Monument Street, right on Wolfe Street, right on Orleans Street, right on Caroline Street, to Monument Street.

Streets to Preston Street and Guilford Avenue, turning left on Guilford Avenue, left on Biddle Street, right on Caroline Street, left on Monument Street, right on Wolfe Street, right on Orleans Street, right on Caroline Street, to Monument Street.

No. 22 Line: Route is blocked on Harford Road between The Alameda and 33rd Street; on 33rd Street between Harford Road and University Parkway.

Service will operate Westbound using the regular route to Erdman Avenue and Harford Road, then right on Harford Road, left on Cold Spring Lane, left on Hillen Road, right on Argonne Drive, continue on 39th Street, right on University Parkway, then continue on the regular route. Eastbound buses will operate on the regular route to University Parkway and 39th Street, then left on 39th Street, continue on Argonne Drive, left on Hillen Road, right on Cold Spring Lane, right on Harford Road, left on Erdman Avenue, then continue on the regular route.

No. 23 Line: Route is blocked on Baltimore Street between Paca Street and Eutaw Street; on Baltimore Street at Light Street; and on Fayette Street at Linwood Avenue.

When Eastbound, buses will operate to Mulberry Street and Fremont Avenue, then right on Fremont Avenue, left on Baltimore Street, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, take I-395 to I-95, exit on O'Donnell Street, right on Ponca Street, right on Lombard Street, then continue on the regular route. When Westbound, buses will operate to Lombard Street and New Ponca Street, then left on O'Donnell Street, take I-95 to I-395 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Baltimore Street, right on Schroeder Street, left on Franklin Street, then continue on the regular route.

No. 27 Line: Route is blocked on Howard Street between 29th Street and Preston Street; on Eutaw Street between Preston & Camden streets; on Russell Street at Camden Street.

Service will operate from Reisterstown Plaza Metro Subway Station to Woodberry Light Rail Stop only. Passengers may use the light rail to continue downtown and points south. Because service will not operate to Port Covington, the No. 29 line will be extended from Port Covington to Westport Light Rail stop. Passengers may take the Light Rail between the Woodberry and Westport stops to continue their trip.

No. 35 Line: Route is blocked on Pratt Street at Paca Street, Eutaw Street, Howard Street, Light Street, and Calvert Street; on Fayette Street between St. Paul Street and Broadway; on Madison Street between Washington Street and Linwood Avenue.

No. 3 Line: Route is blocked on the Alameda between Loch Raven Boulevard and 33rd Street; on 33rd Street between The Alameda and Guilford Avenue; on Guilford Avenue between 33rd Street and 28th Street; on St. Paul Street at 28th Street. Service will operate in two loops as follows:

LOOP ONE: Service will operate between Maryland & North avenues and Charles & Fayette streets. When Northbound, buses will operate from Charles & Fayette streets via the regular route to Charles and 27th Street, left on 27th Street, left on Maryland Avenue, via the regular route to Liberty & Baltimore streets, then left on Baltimore Street, left on Charles Street, stopping in advance of Fayette Street. When Southbound, buses will operate from Maryland & North avenues, then straight on Maryland Avenue, straight on Cathedral Street, straight on Liberty Street, left on Baltimore Street, left on Charles Street stopping in advance of Fayette Street. **LOOP TWO:** Service will also operate between Sheppard Pratt Hospital and Cromwell Bridge Road to The Alameda and Windermere Road, operating on the regular route to the Alameda and Windermere Road, where it will turn on Windermere Road, Ednor Road, and 36th Street, returning northbound on The Alameda, to the regular route.

No. 5 Line: Route is blocked on McCulloh Street between Druid Park Lake Drive and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and Preston Street at Washington Street. Fayette Street will be closed between Calvert Street and Broadway; and Preston Street and Linwood Avenue will be closed. Patrons are encouraged to purchase a Day Pass and use the Metro Subway to connect service. Service will operate in two loops as follows:

LOOP ONE: will operate from Mondawmin Metro Subway Station to Saratoga & Greene streets. When Southbound, buses will operate the regular route to Druid Hill Avenue and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, then right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue, right on Greene Street, right on Saratoga Street, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue to Fulton Avenue, then via the regular route returning to the Mondawmin Metro Subway Station. **LOOP TWO:** will operate from Cedonia. When westbound, buses will operate the regular route to Preston Street and Chester Street, then left on Chester Street, left on Ashland Avenue, left on Collington Avenue, right on Preston Street, then via the regular route returning to the Cedonia loop.

No. 7 Line: Route is blocked on Paca Street between Camden Street and McCulloh Street; on Pratt Street between Light Street and President Street; on Pratt Street between Broadway and Patterson Park Avenue; on Patterson Park Avenue between Pratt Street and Eastern Avenue; on Eastern Avenue between Patterson Park Avenue and Linwood Avenue; on Linwood Avenue between O'Donnell Street and Madison Street; on Boston Street between Wolfe Street and Lakewood Avenue. No service

will operate from East Avenue and Toone Street to Downtown. Service will operate from Mondawmin Metro Subway Station to Greene and Baltimore streets. When Southbound buses will operate the regular route to Greene and Baltimore streets, then right on Lombard Street, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue, then via the regular route to the Mondawmin Metro Subway Station.

When Westbound: buses will operate on the regular route to Pulaski Highway and Haven Street, then left on Haven Street, left on O'Donnell Street, use I-95 to I-395 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Lombard Street, then continue on the regular route to UMBC.

When Eastbound: Via the regular route to Pratt Street and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, then Take I-395 and I-95 to O'Donnell Street, right on Haven Street, right on Pulaski Highway, then continue on the regular route to White Marsh.

No. 36 Line: Route is blocked on 33rd Street between The Alameda and Greenmount Avenue; on Fayette Street at St. Paul Street, Howard Street, Eutaw Street, and Paca Street; on Fayette Street between St. Paul Street and Broadway. Service will be operated in three loops:

LOOP ONE: service will operate between York Road & Northern Parkway and The Alameda & Windermere Road; turning right on Windermere Road, right on Ednor Road, and left on 36th Street, to return northbound to Northern Parkway & York Road. **LOOP TWO:** service will operate between Guilford Avenue & Lexington Street and Kirk Avenue & Gorsuch Avenue; turning left on Gorsuch Avenue, right on Loch Raven Boulevard, right on The Alameda, to return northbound on Kirk Avenue. **LOOP THREE:** service will operate between Riverview and Baltimore Street & Greene Street at the University of Maryland Transit Center.

No. 40 Line: Route is blocked on Baltimore Street between Paca Street and Eutaw Street; on Baltimore Street at Light Street; on Fayette Street between St. Paul Street and Broadway and on Fayette Street at Linwood Avenue.

When Eastbound, buses will operate from Security Square Mall, via the regular route to Mulberry Street and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, then take I-395 and I-95 to Eastern Avenue, continuing on the regular route to Middle River. When Westbound, buses will operate the regular route to Eastern Avenue, take I-95 and I-395 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Franklin Street, continuing on the regular route to Security Boulevard.

No. 48 Line: The No. 48 line will not operate during the Marathon. Passengers will need to use the No. 8 line, or other transit services for this day.

No. 64 Line: Route is blocked on St. Paul Street between 20th Street and Baltimore Street; on Light Street between Baltimore Street and Montgomery Street. Servicew will operate in two loops:

LOOP ONE: service will operate between Guilford Avenue & North Avenue and Guilford Avenue & Lexington Street on Guilford

will operate from East Avenue and Toone Street to Downtown. Service will operate from Mondawmin Metro Subway Station to Greene and Baltimore streets. When Southbound buses will operate the regular route to Greene and Baltimore streets, then right on Lombard Street, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue, then via the regular route to the Mondawmin Metro Subway Station.

No. 8 Line: Route blocked at Greenmount Avenue and 33rd Street; on Fayette Street between Calvert Street and Broadway; on Baltimore Street at Paca, Eutaw and Light streets; on Fayette Street at Paca, Eutaw, and St. Paul streets.

There will be no service to or from the University of Maryland Transit Center on the No. 8 line. Service will connect to the Johns Hopkins Metro Subway Station to assist patrons making connections. Service will operate in two loops as:

LOOP ONE, the north end buses will operate between the Lutherville Light Rail Station and Greenmount & 35th Street using the regular route to Greenmount Avenue & 35th Street, continue left on 35th Street, left on Old York Road, left on 39th Street, right on Greenmount Avenue, then using the regular route Northbound to Lutherville Light Rail Station. **LOOP TWO,** south end buses will operate between Gay & Ensor streets and Greenmount Avenue & 28th Street using the regular route to Greenmount Avenue & 28th Street, then turn left on Mathews Street and left on Exeter Hall Avenue to Greenmount Avenue. Buses will operate via the Johns Hopkins Metro Subway Station to Monument Street, right on Wolfe Street, right on Orleans Street, right on Caroline Street, left on Madison Street, left on Greenmount Avenue, then using the regular route to Gay Street & Ensor Street.

No. 10 Line: Route blocked on Fayette Street between Calvert Street and Broadway, on Baltimore Street at Paca, Eutaw and Light streets; on Fayette Street at Paca, Eutaw and St. Paul streets; and on Eastern Avenue at Linwood Avenue.

When Eastbound, buses will operate to Baltimore Street and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, then right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, straight on I-395, right on I-95, exit on O'Donnell Street, right on Conkling Street, right on Eastern Avenue, then continue using the regular route. When Westbound, buses will operate to Eastern Avenue and Conkling Street, then left on O'Donnell Street to I-95, exiting on I-395 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Lombard Street, then continue using the regular route.

No. 11 Line: Route blocked on Charles Street between 28th and 29th streets; St. Paul Street will be closed from 29th Street to Baltimore Street; Light Street closed between Baltimore Street and Fort Avenue; Baltimore Street is also closed between Paca Street and Eutaw Street. Service will not operate from

Liberty Street and Baltimore Street to Canton Crossing. No. 11 buses will operate in two loops as follows:

Avenue, left on Lexington Street, left on Gay Street, left on Saratoga Street, right on Charles Street, right on North Avenue, right on Guilford Avenue, and continue southbound on the loop. **LOOP TWO:** service will operate between the southern terminus and Greene Street and Mulberry Street on Hanover Street, using I-95 and I-395 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, right on Pennsylvania Avenue, right on Greene Street, to Mulberry Street, returning southbound on Greene Street, continuing on Russell Street, left on Ostend Street, right on Hanover Street, then continuing on the regular route southbound.

No. 91 Line: Route is blocked on Eutaw Street between Preston Street and Baltimore Street; on Fayette Street between St. Paul Street and Frederick Street. Service will operate between Sinai Hospital and Saratoga & Greene streets only. No service will operate from City Hall.

When Southbound, buses will operate the regular route from Sinai Hospital to North & Pennsylvania avenues, continue on North Avenue and turn right on Druid Hill Avenue, right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue, right on Greene Street, right on Saratoga Street, to the Security West Building opposite Pearl Street. When Northbound, buses will operate from Saratoga Street at the Security West Building, then right on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Pennsylvania Avenue, left on North Avenue, then continue on the regular route to Sinai Hospital. There will be no service past Security West to Downtown and City Hall.

No. 98 Line (Hampden Shuttle): Route is blocked at Keswick Road and 33rd Street. Buses will operate between Woodberry and Keswick Road and 33rd Street only, turn right on 33rd Street to return to Woodberry. Service will not operate beyond Keswick Road and 33rd Street to Remington.

Liberty Street and Baltimore Street to Canton Crossing. No. 11 buses will operate in two loops as follows:

LOOP ONE: will operate between Maryland Avenue & 27th Street to Charles & Fayette streets. When Southbound, buses will operate the regular route to Liberty Street and Baltimore Street, then left on Baltimore Street , left on Charles Street to Fayette Street. When Northbound from Charles and Fayette Streets, straight on Charles Street, left on 27th Street, left on Maryland Avenue, to Charles & Fayette streets.

LOOP TWO: will operate from the Towson Loop and Charles Street & Bellona Avenue will operate to 39th Street. Buses will operate along the regular route to Charles & 39th streets, then right on 39th Street, left on University Parkway, left on Charles Street, then via the regular route to the Towson Loop or Charles Street and Bellona Avenue.

No. 12 Line: Route is blocked on 33rd Street at Greenmount Avenue. Bus service will operate between Stella Maris and Greenmount Avenue and 39th Street. There will be no service below 39th Street.

No. 13 Line: Route blocked on McCulloh Street at North Avenue; on Linwood Avenue from O'Donnell Street to Madison Street; on Washington Street between Madison Street and North Avenue. Service will operate in two loops as follows:

LOOP ONE: will operate between North Avenue & Dennison Street and North Avenue & Pennsylvania Avenue. Buses will turn right on Druid Hill Avenue, right on Presstman Street and right on Pennsylvania Avenue, returning to Dennison Street. **LOOP TWO:** will operate between Wolfe & Orleans streets and Calvert Street & North Avenue. Buses will turn right on Caroline Street, left on North Avenue, left on Guilford Avenue, right on Lafayette Avenue, right on Calvert Street to North Avenue, returning via the regular route to Wolfe and Orleans streets.

No. 15 Line: Route is blocked on Saratoga Street between Paca Street and Eutaw Street; at Saratoga Street and St. Paul Street; and at Gay Street & Washington Street. Buses will operate in three loops:

LOOP ONE: service will operate from points west to Saratoga and Greene streets, turning right on Greene Street, right on Fayette Street, right on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to Saratoga Street to continue westbound. **LOOP TWO:** service will operate from Overlea to Milton Avenue and North Avenue, turning on North Avenue, Patterson Park Avenue, Lanvale Street, and back to continue northbound on Belair Road. **LOOP THREE:** service will operate from Gay Street and Ensor Street via the regular route to Broadway and Gay Street, then straight on Broadway, left on Preston Street, left on Caroline Street, right Madison Street, then via the regular route to Hol-

iday Street and Saratoga Street, then turn left on Lexington Street to return on Gay Street.

No. 19 Line: Route blocked on Eutaw Street between Preston & Pratt streets; on Pratt Street between Charles & President streets; on Fayette Street between Light Street and Broadway; on Harford Road between The Alameda and Erdman Avenue. Service will operate two loops:

LOOP ONE: service will operate from the Carney Loop and Goucher Boulevard & Taylor Avenue to Harford Road and Erdman Avenue, turning left on Erdman Avenue, left on Norman Avenue, left on Chesterfield Avenue to return on Harford Road. **LOOP TWO:** service will operate between Harford Road & Homestead Avenue and Gay Street & Ensor Street. When Southbound buses will operate from Harford Road & Homestead Avenue, via the regular route to Harford Road and Monument Street via Johns Hopkins Metro Subway Station, then left on Monument Street, right on Wolfe Street, right on Orleans Street, right on Caroline Street, left on Madison Street, left on Ensor Street, left on Holliday Street, left on Lexington Street, left on Gay Street, to Ensor Street. When Northbound, buses will operate the regular route to Harford Road & Gorsuch Avenue, then turn right on Kirk Avenue and right on The Alameda to Harford Road and Homestead Avenue.

No. 20 Line: Route is blocked on Baltimore Street between Paca and Light streets; on Fayette Street between Calvert Street and Broadway; and on Fayette Street at Linwood Avenue.

When Eastbound, buses will operate the regular route from Security Square Mall and Westview Mall to Baltimore Street at Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, then take Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to I-395, exit on I-95, right on O'Donnell Street, right on Oldham Street, right on Eastern Avenue, to Ponca Street, then continue on the regular route. When Westbound, buses will operate the regular route to New Ponca Street and Oldham Street, then left on Oldham Street, left on O'Donnell Street, take I-95 to I-395, exit on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, left on Baltimore Street, then continue on the regular route.

No. 21 Line: Route is blocked on Dolphin Street at McCulloh Street; on Dolphin Street between Eutaw Street and Howard Street; on Preston Street at St. Paul Street; on Caroline Street at Fayette Street. Service will operate two loops:

LOOP ONE: service will operate from Mondawmin Metro Subway Station the regular route to Dolphin Street and Druid Hill Avenue, right on Druid Hill Avenue, turn on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, right on Pennsylvania Avenue, left on Dolphin Street, then continue on the regular route returning to Mondawmin Metro Subway Station. **LOOP TWO:** service will operate from Caroline and Monument
