The MTA gives notice of five public hearings to provide interested persons the opportunity to comment on proposed service changes to Local Bus line nos. 11, 20, 30, and 36. MTA is also proposing two new bus lines: one to provide improved service to the Amazon Distribution Center located near the intersection of Holabird Ave. and Broening Hwy; the other to better connect Dundalk with the Fleet St./Boston St. corridors. The proposed service changes, which are part of the Bus Network Improvement Project's (BNIP) Phase One Plan, may become effective on February 8, 2015. The public hearing schedule follows:
