Proposal to Eliminate Commuter BusLink 425

The Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA) gives notice of two public hearings to provide interested persons the opportunity to comment on a proposal to eliminate Commuter BusLink 425 service between Baltimore and Aberdeen Proving Ground.

PROPOSAL

MDOT MTA is proposing to eliminate Commuter BusLink 425. This service began operating as a BaltimoreLink expansion service on October 5, 2016.

Justification

- Significant marketing efforts to increase ridership included newspaper notices, radio spots, and banners applied to coaches in the operating area.
- Route 425 currently operates six daily trips between Baltimore City and the Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) with extremely low ridership.
- The expectations for Commuter BusLink routes are to carry 12-15 passengers per trip within the first year of service. Route 425 has been in operation for more than 14 months and averages only 5 passengers per trip.
