



In anticipation of our passengers leaving work early on Wednesday, November 26 (the day before Thanksgiving), MARC afternoon service will be modified as follows **on this day only**. Except as detailed below, all other trains will operate as scheduled.

Penn Line:

- There will be a pre-Holiday Extra train departing from Union Station at 2:50pm, making all stops to Perryville.
- In order to operate this service, **Train 438 (5:20pm departure from Union Station) will not operate**.

Camden Line:


- There will be a pre-Holiday Extra train departing from Union Station at 2:00pm, making all stops to Camden Station.
- In order to operate this service, **Train 850 (5:23pm departure from Union Station) will not operate**.
- Train 852 (5:53pm departure) will make all stops to Camden as requested--Riverdale, College Park, Greenbelt, Jessup, and St. Denis **will be flag stops**.

Brunswick Line:

- Train 871 (normally the Friday - only 1:30pm departure from Union Station) **will operate**, but will hold 15 minutes at Union Station to allow passengers more time to board the train. **It will also continue west of Brunswick, making all stops to Martinsburg.**
- There will also be a pre-Holiday Extra train departing from Union Station at 2:40pm, **making stops that Train 875 normally makes** en route to Martinsburg.
- In order to operate these extra services, Trains 875 and 879 (4:25 and 5:40pm departures from Union Station) **will not operate**.
- PanTran buses **will not operate for Train 873** (3:30pm departure) at Brunswick, however, they will operate for Train 877 (4:55pm departure).

There will be no MARC Train Service on Thanksgiving Day or the day after Thanksgiving. Penn Line passengers are reminded that Amtrak trains do not honor MARC tickets on weekdays that MARC does not operate.

The following is the operational schedule for the MARC Train Service during the Christmas and New Year's holiday season. When referenced below "S" refers to a limited schedule service. Only trains with an "S" under the train number in the printed timetable will operate. In addition, some trains make additional stops when the "S" schedule is in effect, also as noted in the timetable.

Camden Line passengers are reminded that Camden Line one-way, weekly, and monthly tickets are always honored to comparable destinations on the Penn Line.

- ❖ December 23, Full service on all three MARC lines
- ❖ December 24, "S" (limited) schedule on Penn and Brunswick Lines, **no service on the Camden Line**
- ❖ December 25, **No MARC Train Service**
- ❖ December 26 and 27, "S" (limited) schedule on Penn and Brunswick Lines, **no service on the Camden Line**
- ❖ December 28, regularly-scheduled Saturday **Penn Line service**
- ❖ December 29, regularly-scheduled Sunday **Penn Line service**
- ❖ December 30, Full service on all three MARC lines
- ❖ December 31, "S" (limited) schedule on Penn and Brunswick Lines, **no service on the Camden Line**
- ❖ January 1, 2014, **No MARC Train Service**
- ❖ January 2, 2014 and going forward, Full MARC service on all three lines; Penn Line weekend service continues to operate as scheduled.
