Proposal for New Commuter Bus Service

The Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) gives notice of two public hearings to provide interested persons the opportunity to comment on proposed Commuter Bus service on new line No. 425. Proposed New Service for Commuter Bus: Line No. 425

Maryland Department of Transportation's MTA is proposing new service on line No. 425 to accommodate workers traveling from Baltimore and White Marsh to job opportunities in Edgewood and Aberdeen Proving Ground.

Proposed Service:

- Northbound Weekday Morning Service: Proposed to operate between existing stops at Wolfe Street and Monument Street at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore City and Union Avenue and Green Street in Harford County.
- Southbound Weekday Evening Service: Proposed to operate the same route in reverse.
- In addition, this route is proposed to accommodate passengers traveling to Aberdeen Proving Ground with seven stops on the Installation. See map on page 7.


