Here are some of the projects we're working on currently and those that are most likely to have an impact on the traveling public.

METRO SUBWAY

METRO Portal, RP West, and RA East Interlocking Reconstruction

DESCRIPTION: Full replacement of three interlockings on METRO mainline, with associated drainage improvements and straight track replacement

IMPACT: Reisterstown Plaza, Rogers Ave, and West Cold Spring stations will be closed from July 22 until August 14. Subway will operate as usual from Owings Mills to Milford Mill and from Mondawmin to Johns Hopkins. An express bus shuttle will be provided between Milford Mill and Mondawmin, as well as a local bus shuttle which will make stops at the three closed stations.

Rehab and Repairs to Metro Aerial, Bridge, and Station Structures

DESCRIPTION: Concrete repairs at the West Cold Spring Metro Station.

IMPACT: Certain portions of the mezzanine level pedestrian walking areas will be temporarily closed and patrons will be redirected accordingly.

Old Court Metro Station Roof Replacement

DESCRIPTION: Roof replacement.

IMPACT: Certain sections of the pedestrian/ticketing area on the mezzanine level will be temporarily closed during the installation of roof drains. Patrons will be redirected accordingly.



LIGHT RAIL

Cromwell Light Rail Storm Water Facility Retrofit

DESCRIPTION: Maintenance on the existing storm water management pond at the south side of the parking lot and access road.

IMPACT: Construction will restrict part of the south drive along the curbed grass area and between the entrance and parking area.
