


THE MTA STUDENT TRANSIT S-PASS RULES.

- Only use your MTA Student Transit S-Pass weekdays between 6am – 8pm.
- Protect your S-Pass just like you would with cash. It's valuable!
- Be careful not to bend or damage your pass.
- Only YOU can use your MTA Student Transit S-Pass. Don't give or lend it to anyone.
- Contact your school principal's office if your S-Pass is lost or damaged.
- Always have your school identification available to show when requested by an MTA official.

- HONOR** your family, school, peers and community.

- REMEMBER** that the driver/operator is in charge.
- SPEAK SOFTLY** without name calling or mean language.
- STAND BEHIND THE YELLOW LINE** at train stations.
- USE HEADPHONES** when using sound devices onboard.
- RESPECT** others and help discourage negative activity.
