IT'S EASY TO GET DOWNTOWN WITH MTA

Get to all the action using Metro Subway from Owings Mills, Light Rail from Hunt Valley, BWI Airport and Penn Station, and Local Buses from all over town! The cost for these options is just \$1.60 one-way or \$3.50 for a Day Pass. Ample free parking is available at many Light Rail stops and Metro Subway stations.



PURCHASE A \$10 STAR SPANGLED SPECTACULAR COMMEMORATIVE CHARMCARD®

This tap-and go pass comes pre-loaded with three one-day passes so you can roam freely wherever MTA Metro Subway, Local Bus and Light Rail travel. Just click on the appropriate rotating banner at mta.maryland.gov for details.



TRAVELING FROM THE WASHINGTON D.C. AREA?

MARC Train Weekend Service on the Penn Line will take you to Baltimore's Penn Station conveniently and affordably, where you can catch the Nos. 3, 11, 61 or 64 Local Bus from St. Paul Street to downtown. Light Rail direct from Penn Station will also get you downtown where you can exit at Camden Yards, then walk a few blocks to the Inner Harbor at Light and Conway streets for service to Fort McHenry via the Local Bus No. 1 and the Fort McHenry Express. Commuter Bus service Route No. 201 is available from Gaithersburg Park and Ride to the BWI Airport Light Rail Stop, where you can take Light Rail to downtown.

1 TO THE INNER HARBOR AND FORT MCHENRY BY METRO SUBWAY AND BUS

Take Metro Subway to the Charles Center Station (Charles Street exit), just three easy-walking blocks from the Inner Harbor. You can also catch the Local Bus No. 1 and Fort McHenry Express at Charles and Baltimore streets if you prefer to ride. The express bus continues on to the Fort McHenry area* after making a stop at the Inner Harbor at Light and Conway streets.

1 TO THE INNER HARBOR AND FORT MCHENRY BY LIGHT RAIL AND BUS

Take Light Rail to the University Center/Baltimore Street Stop, then walk three blocks east to Charles and Baltimore streets, where you can catch the Local Bus No. 1 and Fort McHenry Express to the Inner Harbor and Fort McHenry area*. Or if you're going directly to the Inner Harbor, get off at Camden Yards and walk three blocks east via Conway Street.

2 TO CANTON WATERFRONT PARK AND FELLS POINT

Catch Local Bus No. 7 or No. 11 at marked MTA stops.

* Customers should expect to walk from the bus termination point to the Fort McHenry gate due to special security restrictions. MTA will provide an ADA shuttle to the front gate of Fort McHenry for those requiring assistance. The Fort McHenry Express bus runs Saturday and Sunday only. Fort McHenry drop-off points for both the Fort McHenry Express and the No. 1 Local Bus are as follows: Tue. 9/9-Wed. 9/10 and Mon. 9/15-Tue. 9/16: Constellation Plaza at Fort McHenry; Thurs. 9/11 thru Sun. 9/14: Francis Scott Key Elementary School.

3 TO PATTERSON PARK

Pick up Local Bus Nos. 10, 20 or QuickBus 40 at marked MTA stops.

TO MARTIN STATE AIRPORT



Take MARC Train Service on the Penn Line until you get to the Martin State Airport Station, or take Local Bus No. 24 from downtown.

4 TO PORT COVINGTON

Board Local Bus No. 64 at marked MTA stops.
