Project Status and Schedule

Phase 3 Construction Begins Mid-Summer!

Phase 1 (Fall 2013 – Spring 2014)

COMPLETE

The new, fully signalized intersection on MD 193 was activated in early May 2014, and the Langley Park Shopping Center entrance was reopened to the public. Phase 1 improves the signal at MD 650 (New Hampshire Avenue) and Lebanon Street. Mid-block pedestrian crosswalks on MD 193 (University Boulevard) have been removed, replaced and relocated with signalized crosswalks to improve safety.

Phase 2 (Spring 2014 – Summer 2014)

Phase 2 of construction at the MD 650 entrance near the Bank of America began in May 2014. Our work in this area includes significant improvements to the existing entrance and a modified traffic signal and crosswalk that will improve safety conditions in the area. Phase 2 will also include the construction of a pedestrian walkway to guide pedestrians safely around the future Transit Center site.

Phase 3 (Summer 2014 – Winter 2015)

Phase 3 is planned to begin in mid-summer 2014. This phase continues our efforts to improve pedestrian safety with modifications to the existing median and traffic signals. These modifications have been carefully planned to maximize pedestrian and vehicular safety in the immediate vicinity of the Transit Center. Phase 3 will culminate with the construction of the Transit Center roof canopy, bus loop and facility building.
